1. **COSPAR** - Committee on Space Research
COSPAR's objectives are to promote on an international level scientific research in space, with emphasis on the exchange of results, information and opinions, and to provide a forum, open to all scientists, for the discussion of problems that may affect scientific space research.

2. **IAF** - International Astronautical Federation
The Federation is the world's leading space advocacy body with over 270 members, including all key space agencies, companies, societies, associations and institutes across 64 countries. - Increases educational benefits of World Space Week by providing teachers with classroom activities that use space to excite students about learning;
- Inspires students globally by flying representative students in simulated zero gravity airplane flights.



9. **YouSpace** - YouSpace, an international partnership about innovation, events, success stories, job opportunities, dialogues, internships in the space sector between students, universities, research centers, industries and institutions, including the European ones.

We organize:

- "Meeting Space Mentors/Space Mentees" twice a year with a call of each participant.
